Welcome to the bilingual beginner English book for EnglishAcademy.Online. This edition places Urdu translations alongside every English item to support Urdu-speaking learners. Use one unit per lesson or adapt pacing as needed.

How to use this book

Suggested pacing: one unit per class (60 minutes) or one unit per two self-study sessions. Each unit contains: a dialogue, 20 target words with Urdu translations, a grammar focus with Urdu explanations, pronunciation notes, exercises with Urdu instructions, and a short role-play.

Pronunciation Guide – تلفظ گا ئی

This section explains English letters, short and long vowels, and common consonant sounds with Urdu translations and examples. Each example shows the English word, a simple phonetic cue, and its Urdu translation.

Mini Grammar Reference – مختصر گرامر حوالہ

Covers Present Simple, Subject Pronouns, Articles (a/an/the), Wh-questions, and Common Negation. Each rule is shown in English with a brief Urdu explanation and two example sentences with Urdu translations.
