

Beginner English with Hindi

Welcome to the bilingual beginner English book for Hindi-speaking students at EnglishAcademy.Online. This edition places Hindi translations alongside every English item to support learners whose first language is Hindi.

How to use this book

Suggested pacing: one unit per class (60 minutes) or one unit per two self-study sessions. Each unit contains: a short dialogue, 20 target words with Hindi translations, a grammar focus with Hindi explanations, pronunciation practice, exercises with Hindi instructions, and a short role-play.

Contents

- Unit 1: Greetings – Dialogue, vocabulary (20 words), basic questions, role-play (Hindi translations).
- Unit 2: Numbers – Cardinal numbers 1–100, practice exercises, Hindi numerals and examples.
- Unit 3: Family – Family vocabulary, possessive adjectives, sample sentences with Hindi translations.
- Unit 4: Daily Routines – Simple present tense, daily activities vocabulary, timeline exercise with Hindi prompts.
- Unit 5: Classroom – Common classroom words, classroom commands, pair-work activities with Hindi instructions.
- Unit 6: Food – Food vocabulary, likes/dislikes, ordering food dialogue with Hindi lines.
- Unit 7: Time & Dates – Telling time, days, months, simple calendar expressions with Hindi equivalents.
- Unit 8: Directions – Prepositions of place, asking for directions dialogue, map activity with Hindi cues.
- Unit 9: Shopping – Useful phrases, prices and numbers, role-play: buying items with Hindi prompts.
- Unit 10: Health & Body – Body parts, basic health phrases, describing symptoms with Hindi translations.
- Unit 11: Weather – Weather vocabulary, simple forecasts, speaking practice with Hindi instructions.
- Unit 12: Review & Conversation – Mixed practice, cumulative review exercises, final beginner test with Hindi instructions.

Pronunciation Guide

A short pronunciation guide covering English letters, short and long vowels, common consonant clusters, and typical problem sounds for Hindi speakers (e.g., v/w, b/v, th sounds). Each point is explained in Hindi and includes English example words and their Hindi translations.

Grammar Reference (Mini)

Present simple: form and use (with Hindi explanation and examples), articles (a/an/the) explained in Hindi with examples, forming yes/no and wh- questions with Hindi translations.

Three short quizzes (units 1–4, units 5–8, units 9–12), a mid-course review, and a final beginner test. All instructions and questions include Hindi translations; answer keys are provided in English with Hindi explanations for common errors.

Each unit includes a suggested 60-minute lesson plan with time allocations for warm-up, presentation, controlled practice, communicative practice, and wrap-up. Teacher-facing tips include error-correction phrases in Hindi, differentiation suggestions for mixed-ability classes, and printable flashcard lists labeled in Hindi.

Grammar Focus

Introducing yourself: Subject + verb (to be) + complement. Examples with Hindi translations: "I am a student." – "मैं एक छात्र हूँ" Practice: replace subject and complement to make new sentences.

Practice Exercises

- Exercise 1 (Fill in the blanks) – Instructions in Hindi: खाली जगह भरो।
- Exercise 2 (Match the pairs) – Match English phrases with Hindi translations.
- Exercise 3 (Role-play) – In pairs, practice the dialogue. One student plays A and the other B; switch roles. Instructions provided in Hindi.

- 50 common verbs with simple present conjugation examples and Hindi equivalents.
- Printable flashcards: English on one side, Hindi on the other.
