

# Beginner English with Telugu

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Welcome to the bilingual beginner English book for Telugu-speaking learners at EnglishAcademy.Online. This edition places Telugu translations alongside every English item to support learners whose first language is Telugu.

## How to use this book

Suggested pacing: one unit per class (60 minutes) or one unit per two self-study sessions. Each unit contains a short dialogue with line-by-line Telugu translation, 20 target words with Telugu equivalents, a grammar focus with Telugu explanations, practice exercises with Telugu instructions, and a role-play for speaking practice.

## Contents

- Unit 2: Numbers – Counting 1–100, number words, exercises, Telugu equivalents

## Sample Unit Structure (applies to every unit)

1. Dialogue: one short conversation in English followed by a line-by-line Telugu translation.
2. Vocabulary: 20 target words/phrases listed in a two-column table (English | Telugu).
3. Grammar Focus: short explanation in English with Telugu translation and two example sentences with Telugu equivalents.
4. Practice Exercises: fill-in-the-blanks, matching, short-answer questions – instructions and model answers provided in Telugu.
5. Role-play: two short role-play prompts with Telugu cue-phrases for teachers and students.

## Pronunciation Guide

A concise pronunciation guide covering: the English alphabet, short and long vowels, common consonant clusters (e.g., 'th', 'sh', 'ch'), word stress basics, and linked speech tips. Each point is accompanied by Telugu explanations and example words with Telugu translations.

## Mini Grammar Reference

Quick-reference pages for: Present Simple (affirmative, negative, questions), Articles (a/an/the), Pronouns, Demonstratives (this/that/these/those), and basic question words (who/what/where/when/why/how). Each rule includes Telugu explanations and two bilingual example sentences.
